It brings together all of our high performance and promising players from our different Fireball venues to share in and celebrate being part of a tournament trip away from home.



It also provides our Fireball coaches with the opportunity to work with their players in a different environment from our traditional club setting which naturally strengthens the player-coach bond.

This trip is aimed at both our high performance players currently competing in tennis tournaments, as well as kids new to tennis tournaments, as it provides a brilliant opportunity for these kids to start playing tournaments through the fun and supportive group environment supported by our Fireball coaches.

- Obtain an Australian Ranking (Fireball currently has 35 nationally ranked players)
- Play National Championships
- Represent the state (Team Vic)
- Compete in international events

As the tournament is an Australian Ranking event, it will be a strong tournament and will be a great eye-opening experience for all players. Players will learn about all the details that add up to peak performance, including:

- Hydration/nutrition
- Pre-match routines (eg, warm up, etc)
- Match tactics
- Post-match routines (eg, stretching, match analysis, etc)
- Practicing with a purpose

All aspects our trip will be fully supervised and organised by the Fireball coaching team, including food, travel, and accommodation. Parents will also be more than welcome to come up to Bendigo with us if they want to support their kids, however they will need to organise your own accommodation/transport.
